





- NGO services that are produced for public good since 1994
- VSF is financed by Finnish Slot Machine Association and the Ministry of Justice. The youth project is funded by the Association.
- The services are targeted for crime victims, their close ones and witnesses of crime
- Most of the customers are victims of different sorts of violence related crimes



# PROJECT FOR YOUNG VICTIMS OF CRIME. KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND SUPPORT 2012-2015

- Aim is to develop an effective and targeted communication for young victims of crime so that they can get help and support
- Education for professionals so that they can identify and support young victims of crime
- During the project the services of VSF will also be developed in order to better answer the needs of young people



# WHAT IS MEANT BY SOCIAL MEDIA

- Online collaborative activities, discussions and sharing of information and pictures
- Various different images and chat services are central
- Constantly changing and developing


# ONLINE ACTIVITIES OF CHILDREN AND YOUNG PEOPLE

- Kids go into internet even at the age of 4 to 5 years
- Young Europeans (9-16 year of age): more than 90% use the Internet at least once a week and over 60% every day (80% of Finnish)
- About 50% of young people use the Internet in their rooms


# 60% OF YOUNG PEOPLE HAVE A COMMUNITY PROFILE

EU KIDS ONLINE (2010) N= 25 142






- Young people would tell to a friend if they would end up as a victim of a crime


# OULU: SCHOOL STABBING 10/10/2013, BY 16-YEAR-OLD, FOUR SERIOUSLY INJURED

- Next week there was VSF's worker at the school



## HOW DO WE USE THE INFORMATION





- The results work as a base for group discussions and blogs





# PARENTS FIGHTING USUALLY INCLUDES... (N= 468)





To whom it would be easiest to talk about sexual assault? (N=437)





If you have experienced emotional violence,




# What would be the most difficult situation to start telling about the sexual assault?



